

# Permissions - Access to publish public keys (permalinks)

There is a new option in Eainfoport to set "Access to publish public keys" for users.

After installing version 8.7.0, users who create permalinks must set the permissions otherwise they will lose this option.

Setting option:

- 1) Portal Management > Users management > Repositories > select the required permissions
- 2) Click on Repository Model > Repository Management > Users Management > Permissions
